FLEET MANAGEMENT

Valgrove is situated at West Bromwich and Bilston, our fleet of vacuum tankers, which range from 3000 gallon to 6000 gallon in capacity, are ideally located near to the motorway network. The vehicles, which travel the length and breadth of this country as well as in Europe, are all maintained to the highest standard. All our drivers are ADR trained, to City & Guilds standard, to transport dangerous goods in bulk or drums, safely. Each vehicle is fitted with a satellite navigation system for ease of planning and quick response.

WASTE CARRIERS

Under regulation 3 of the Controlled Waste (Registration of Carriers and Seizure of Vehicles) Regulations 1991, anyone collecting or arranging the transporting and / or disposal of waste, with certain exceptions, must be registered with the Environment Agency as a waste carrier and Broker. Valgrove are registered with the Environment Agency as waste carriers & Brokers. Licence No. CBDU80636.

THE SERVICE

Having obtained a representative sample, Valgrove will assist the producer in determining the most practical and cost effective option when dealing with their waste. When making a collection, Valgrove will supply documentation to ensure that the producer meets their responsibility under Section 34 of 'The Environmental Protection (Duty of Care) Act 1991. If the waste is deemed to be Hazardous Waste, Consignment Notes, can also be supplied and completed to ensure that the producer meets their responsibility under the 'Hazardous Waste (England & Wales) Regulations 2005. Alternatively, the producer can raise the documentation for Valgrove to transfer the waste or product to a destination of their choice.

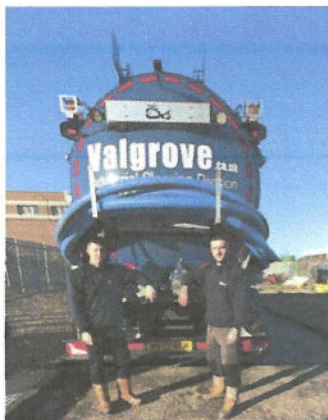

All our operatives are fully trained and experienced for entering confined spaces, high pressure water jetting, tank cutting & first aid and in the use of associated specialised equipment etc.

We provide waste management to:

Our operatives work to the highest standards using heavy duty vacuum tankers, which includes a Vacter capable of pumping sludges from depths of around 100 feet. A Jetvac, which not only can jet at high pressure but pump up the washings created in the cleaning process. High pressure jetting equipment to carry out work such as unblocking drains & culverts and decontaminating floor areas and tanks, whether in open or confined spaces.

Recycling Controlled Waste to Land

Recycling Waste to Land

Manufacturers are not only being encouraged to reduce their waste, but to consider options other than disposal. Options such as reusing or recycling.

The Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994 allow for specific types of waste to be recycled to land providing that it results in 'benefit to agriculture' or 'ecological' improvement'.

The application of waste materials to agricultural land utilises the natural ability of soils to breakdown organic wastes into useful by-products. In this context, soils can be considered as efficient biological digesters that gain benefit from recycling useful wastes and by-products. Farmers derive benefit from wastes containing plant nutrients and soil-conditioning properties - waste producers can have the security of a sustainable waste management system.

The suitability of a waste material for recycling to agricultural land is based on regular independent chemical analysis, process audit and risk-benefit analysis which provide the necessary information to produce an 'agricultural benefit' or 'ecological improvement' statement required by the Environment Agency. Typically the waste materials are analysed for pH, Solids Content, Major Plant Nutrients and Potentially Toxic Elements. Further specific analysis may be conducted e.g. for minor plant nutrients and in order to identify any potential environmental risk.

Our staff, in consultation with the agricultural community, arrange suitable areas of land for our recycling operations to take place. Part of the process includes the sampling and analysis of all fields to be spread, and, conducting a risk-benefit analysis, ensuring that there is no adverse environmental effect.

Recycling in this way can provide an economic and sustainable waste management solution that is consistent with the principals of Best Available Techniques Not Entailing Excessive Costs (BATNEEC) and Best Practical Environmental Option (BPEO). Together with our trading partners, Valgrove provides a complete beneficial recycling service.

Strict environmental controls and regulations mean that recycling waste to land is a specialised business.

Controlled wastes recycled onto agricultural land are also subject to the 'Duty of Care' imposed by Section 34 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990.

To ensure that waste producers comply with their 'Duty of Care', Valgrove will assist and advise wherever possible to ensure full compliance by providing documentation which will enable waste producers to meet their legal obligations.

Collections

Valgrove Ltd., Under regulation 3 of the Controlled Waste (Registration of Carriers and Seizure of Vehicles) Regulations 1991, are registered with the Environment Agency as a waste carrier, registration number CBDU80636.

Our drivers are trained and hold ADR certificates for carriage of dangerous goods - in tanks & other than in tanks (drums).

All waste is collected using Duty of Care Transfer Notes and where applicable Special Waste Documentation (S62),. copies of which are left with the producer and retained by Valgrove in accordance with the regulations.

All collections and transfers are recorded on our system for ease of traceability.

Our fleet of self loading vacuum tankers, which include specialised tankers such Vacter and Jetvac, are capable of transporting 24 tonnes or more. Curtain sided vehicles are capable of carrying up to 100 drum loads.

The Valgrove 'Vacter', a member of the 'kilo-Whale' family, is purpose built and designed to clean and maintain large diameter deep sewers. With a pump capable of delivering up to 1,000 cubic metres of airflow, it can remove heavy sludges from depths of around 100 feet. The hydraulic hose support booms, situated on each side of the barrel and the electric powered winch ensures that the maximum number of hoses can be deployed and retrieved with the minimum of effort.
